

## Magellan - the \$1.2bn ultimate residential cruise ship comes to Dubai

Residential Cruise Line, the operator of Magellan, has just inaugurated the sales launch of the 210 residential units for full ownership.

The announcement was made at the press conference held at Jumeirah Emirates Towers, Dubai.
