PHOENIX, Ariz., USA – Imagine touring the world, 300 ports in 150 countries, from the comfort of your own exclusive, floating home. The new ultimate in luxury is purchasing a condo on the world's largest private residential cruise ship, the Magellan.

The \$750 million-dollar ship features 210 units and world-class amenities, such as a tennis court, retractable marina, two putting greens, an observatory, four fine dining restaurants, an all-weather heliport, Aqua Spa, casino, gourmet marketplace, microbrewery, 430-seat Broadway-style theatre, two pools and more. Owners can reach the Magellan via the ship's two executive jet helicopters, Venetian tenders or at ports.

Historic astronaut Buzz Aldrin, future Magellan resident, says, "In 1969, Neil Armstrong and I were the first two men to walk on the moon during the Apollo 11 mission. I have always been drawn to exploration, seeking out new experiences and constantly pushing new frontiers. My wife Lois and I look forward to exploring the world on the Magellan."

The Magellan will circumnavigate the globe every two years. Scheduled ports include Barcelona, Monte Carlo, Istanbul, Stockholm, New York, Miami, Rio de Janeiro, Acapulco, Vancouver, Shanghai, Hong Kong, Sydney, Bali, Honolulu and Alexandria.

The Magellan's residences all feature fine wood cabinetry, stainless steel appliances, granite surfaces, marble baths, china, crystal and spectacular ocean views. Residences start at \$2.34 million for full ownership. Magellan also offers the unique opportunity to buy fractional ownership of one month or two weeks per year, starting at \$140,000.

Randall Jackson, chief executive officer of Residential Cruise Line, Ltd., developed the Magellan concept of richly appointed residences and five-star service. "I was touring the Strait of Magellan during a holiday cruise with my family when I envisioned the possibility of a home-away-from-home touring the seven seas in the greatest of luxury."

Jackson, a prominent Arizona real estate developer, former luxury motor yacht dealer, and former commercial and military pilot, has attracted the world's top shipbuilding and design firms to work with his company to create the Magellan. The ship will be built at Aker Yards in France and is scheduled to set sail in 2010.
